**EXTENDED HOURS AT THE CALIFORNIA MUSEUM FOR LAST TEN DAYS OF
WITH MALICE TOWARD NONE: THE ABRAHAM LINCOLN BICENTENNIAL EXHIBITION**

(Sacramento, CA) – Due to the overwhelming popularity of the Library of Congress *With Malice Toward None: The Abraham Lincoln Bicentennial Exhibition* at The California Museum, hours have been extended.

Museum guests can see the Lincoln exhibition the last ten days, starting Thursday, August 13th to Sunday, August 23rd, from 9am to 6pm. In the past six weeks, nearly 27,000 guests have visited The California Museum for this once in a lifetime experience.

The only venue on the West Coast, the exhibit contains nearly 200 objects, which include the contents of Lincoln's pockets the night he was assassinated, the Bible used by Lincoln and Obama for their oaths of office, a rare copy of the Emancipation Proclamation and a facsimile of the Gettysburg Address.
