SACRAMENTO, Calif. -- Actor Jack Nicholson, fitness guru Jack LaLanne and jazz legend Dave Brubeck will be among those inducted later this year into the California Hall of Fame.

The California Museum for History, Women and the Arts issues the honors as a way of celebrate people who embody the state's innovative spirit and have made their mark on history.

Others to be inducted include Jane Fonda, Theodor Geisel, Robert Graham, Quincy Jones, Dorothea Lange, Julia Morgan, Linus Pauling, Leland Stanford and Alice Waters.

The ceremony will be followed by the unveiling of the new exhibit installation, featuring artifacts and mementos personally loaned by the inductees, their families and organizations, including many items that have never been exhibited before.
